

## Guidelines for book reviews

Book reviews can be submitted in German (new spelling) or English (consistent British or American English) and should refer to monographs or anthologies not older than 18 months. Please keep book reviews shorter than 800 words. The managing editors will decide on the acceptance. On request we can send you a review copy of the book you are interested in reviewing.

Details of the book should be stated at the beginning of your review as in the following example:

Hodgson, G.M. (1999): Evolution and Institutions. On Evolutionary Economics and the Evolution of Economics, Cheltenham et al. (360 pages, hardcover, Edward Elgar Publishing, ISBN 1-85898-813-6)

Indicate your correspondence address including e-mail address and try to use gender sensitive formulations. For highlighting please use only one sort of emphasis (bold, italics or quotation marks).
